Minority Scholarship

There will be a total annual financial assistance for African-American students available through this program of two full tuition scholarships (or one full and two partial.) The purpose of this scholarship is to provide qualified students with financial assistance to enable them to attend Central Holmes Christian School. This scholarship is available for students grades 1-12. In order to apply the student must complete the enrollment process and pay associated fees for such and/or be in good financial standing with Central Holmes Christian School. All complete applications will be submitted to a selection committee of outside individuals. Recipients will be notified by mail.

General Requirements

Academic

- * Applicants must score at or above the 50th percentile on any achievement tests from the previous school year. A copy of this must be provided.
- * The applicants must have maintained a "B" average for three previous semesters in which they have attended an accredited educational institution. A copy of the student's transcript is required.
- * The applicants must maintain a "C" average for each semester to retain the financial aid.

Character and Citizenship

- * Applicants must submit three letters of recommendation attesting to their good moral character, honesty, integrity, and scholarship. One of these letters must be from a school official with the applicant's immediate prior school.
- * The applicants, once accepted, must adhere to all of the school's rules, regulations and by-laws.
