

NATIONAL COLLEGIATE ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION ELIGIBILITY

The NCAA Initial-Eligibility Clearinghouse is an organization that works with the NCAA to determine a student's eligibility for athletics participation in his or her first year of college enrollment. Students who want to participate in college sports during their first year of enrollment in college must register with the clearinghouse.

Every prospective student-athlete who is attending an NCAA Division I or II institution for the first time must be certified by the clearinghouse.

Register with the eligibility center – www.eligibilitycenter.org

After your junior year, request a copy of your transcript from your guidance counselor. If you have attended more than 1 high school be certain you request a transcript from each to be submitted to the eligibility center.

When taking the ACT or SAT, request test scores to be sent to the eligibility center – code 9999

Begin the amateurism questionnaire

When taking the ACT or SAT, request test scores to be sent to the eligibility center – code 9999

Complete the amateurism questionnaire and sign the final authorization signature online on or after April 1 – if you are expecting to enroll in college in the fall semester. (If you are expecting to enroll for spring semester, sign the final authorization signature on or after October 1 of the year prior to enrollment.)

Request a final transcript that includes proof of graduation from your high school counselor to be submitted to the eligibility center.

ACT Scores: ACT test scores must be reported to the clearinghouse directly from ACT. The Clearinghouse will NOT accept test scores reported on high school transcripts. When registering to take the ACT be certain you mark the code 9999 so that the testing agency will send your scores on your behalf to the Clearinghouse. Students already registered to take the ACT may contact ACT (319*337*1270) to add a report to NCAA Clearinghouse until 12:00 noon, CST, on Thursday immediately following the national test date. You may also visit www.actstudent.org to request an ACT score to be sent to the NCAA Clearinghouse. Under services click “send your scores.”
